The ACE Mentor Program is a nationally based program that provides mentoring to high school juniors and seniors who are interested in pursuing careers in Architecture, Construction, or Engineering. We immerse students in real world problem solving, challenge them with industry specific problems, and support them as they grow and learn.

The Chicago chapter of ACE works in partnership with Chicago Public Schools and puts a particular emphasis on low to moderate income students. Since its founding, the Chicago program has impacted the lives of over 1500 students from 40 Chicago area high schools. In addition to mentoring, we have awarded 109 internships and 445 scholarships totalling over one million dollars.

The ACE Associate Board aims to provide further assistance to graduates of the ACE program through additional alumni scholarships, as well as assistantships with our summer design build program. These scholarships and opportunities are awarded to outstanding former ACE students who are actively pursuing a degree in one of the ACE fields. We raise funds for this specific purpose each year at our ACE Summer Fundraiser, and this is where we need your help!
