Award Amount

One (1) \$2,000 scholarship, paid annually for a maximum of three (3) years or until graduation.

Eligibility

Must have been enrolled in the ACE Mentor Program Chicago chapter during high school.

Must be currently enrolled in an Engineering related program and pursuing an engineering degree.

Must have completed at least 1 full year of post-secondary education. Graduate students are eligible, however preference will be given to undergraduate students.

Additional Information

Applicants may not be current recipients of a fully funded education from another organization (ie: armed services or employer reimbursement or other fully funded scholarship).
