Awarded By

The family of Eli W. Cohen, a renowned structural engineer who helped to forge the Chicago skyline, and founded the consulting firm that became Thornton Tomasetti Chicago

Amount

One (1) \$2,000 scholarship, paid annually for a maximum of three (3) years or until graduation

Timeline

Recipients will be notified of scholarship selection by mid-April

Eligibility

Must have been enrolled in the ACE Mentor Program Chicago chapter during high school.

Must be currently enrolled in an Engineering-related college/university program and pursuing an engineering degree.

Must have completed at least 1 full year of post-secondary education. Graduate students are eligible, however preference will be given to undergraduate students.

Additional Information

Applicants may not be current recipients of a fully funded education from another organization (ie: armed services or employer reimbursement or other fully funded scholarship).
