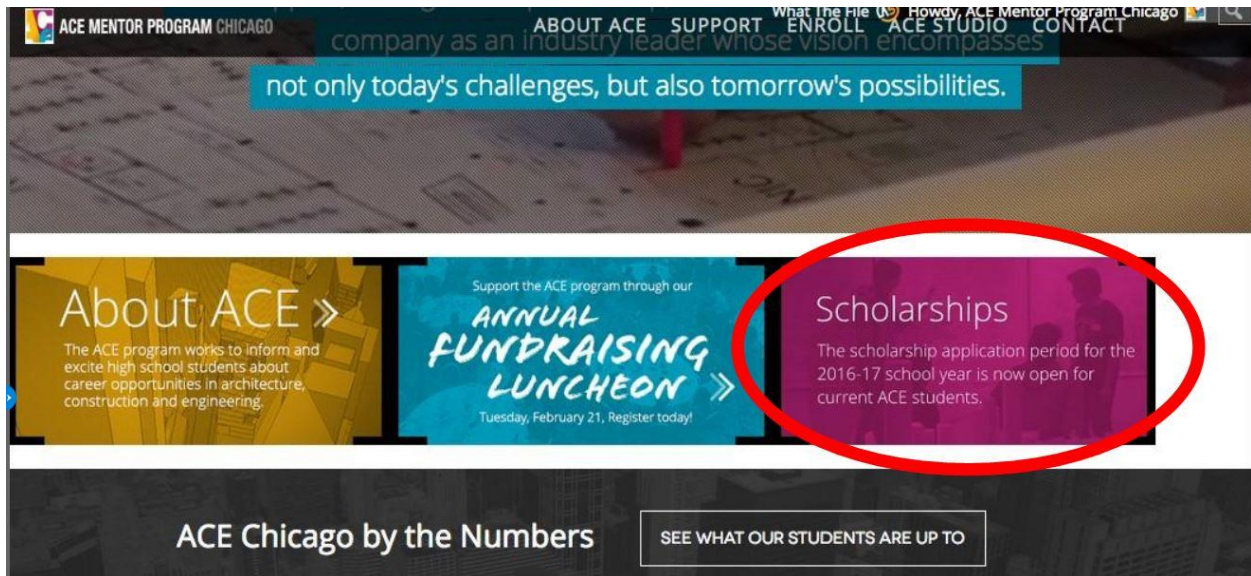




A limited number of monetary and non-monetary awards are available for current students of the ACE Mentor Program of Chicago. Potential awards include **scholarships, internships, and selection to the Summer Design-Build Workshop**. Awards are provided to exceptional students based on their performance in ACE, and considering attendance, participation, aptitude, character and future goals. While sophomores are welcome to apply, preference will be given to juniors and seniors.

Students may apply for all or any of these awards:

College Scholarship

Monetary awards intended to support our students in paying for post-secondary education are provided by ACE Chicago. *(Returning students who have previously won an ACE scholarship are eligible and encouraged to apply again).* To qualify, a student must demonstrate:

- Intention to enroll as a full-time student in a program related to architecture, engineering or construction at an accredited college or university within two school of HS graduation
- Social Security # is **NOT** required

Summer Internship

Our summer internships at our member firms are our highest and most valuable awards. Not only do internship winners receive a competitive wage, they also gain extremely valuable work experience in design, engineering or construction management firms, and make important contacts that will benefit them throughout their careers. To qualify, a student must demonstrate:

- Proof of eligibility to work (e.g., Social Security #) **IS** required.
- Availability to work full-time Monday through Fri for at least 7 weeks during the summer.
- Able and willing to meet the conditions for summer employment as offered by employers.

Candidates for internships may be interviewed in person or by phone by the hiring company.

2017 Design-Build Workshop

The ACE Design-Build Workshop is an exciting summer program that develops design and construction skills through a 7-week, hands-on summer studio. Entry to the workshop is offered only to select ACE students, who will be solely responsible for the design and construction of a real project with a real client. Selection includes free admission and an additional \$1500 scholarship award upon completion. For more information, please visit acementorchicago.org/designbuild/

- To qualify, a student must be available Mon - Fri for 7 weeks in the summer (8am – noon, June 22 – Aug 11) and be dedicated to a successful team project! Soc Security # is **NOT** req.

5. What was the most valuable lesson you learned from your time with the ACE Mentor program?

6. Additional Essay Is there anything else you wish to share with the scholarship committee?
You may include special circumstances or hardships that you have overcome.

F. Award Consideration

ACE Chicago wants to know which awards you want to be considered for. Students chosen for internships will not also win other scholarship awards but students who participate in the design/build may also win other scholarships.

You are required to submit one recommendation from a teacher or guidance counselor who is familiar with your talents and interests in architecture, construction management, or engineering. You may also submit a second recommendation from an employer or another teacher if desired, but only one recommendation letter is required.

Have your recommender fill out the form and return it to you electronically as a PDF file. Be sure to give the person recommending you enough time to write a recommendation and return it to you in time for you to submit it before the scholarship application deadline.

Any fields with a red background must be filled in or the application cannot be saved. Additionally, you are **REQUIRED** to check the box to Certify. (Section I. Certification) for **BOTH** saving and submitting your application. If you notice that you cannot save or submit your application, scroll up to make sure that Certification box is checked and all red boxes are filled out. An example of the red highlighted boxes is shown below.

Note: You will not be required to fill out the essay or upload documents to **SAVE**, but they are required for final submission. Please make sure you have submitted those or your application will not be considered complete at review time.
